

Beehive Activity – One to One Correspondence

1. Hand out one hive to each student (each will have a different number), ensure hive card is placed so that the bee outlines are facing up.
2. Dump pile of bees in the middle of the table
3. Say (to all):
 - ***Take some bees and put one bee into each 'bee-space' (point to outlines) on your card***
4. Wait until all have finished placing their bees (may need to ask early finishers to be patient!).
5. Say (to each student in turn):
 - ***How many bees do you have on your hive?***
6. Regardless of the accuracy of the student's answer, say (to all):
 - ***Lets count them together***
7. Once the bees have been counted, repeat the question (in step 5) to the student.
8. Repeat activity after redistributing hives – ensuring students who had problems get lower numbers while proficient students get higher numbers without making this apparent to the students.
9. Note which students need more practice or help with this and which are ready to move on
