

Numeral Dot Addition Bingo

Number of Students: Pairs

Materials:

- 1 Numeral Dot Addition Bingo game board per pair
- 1 Spinner 1-9 numerals (1 per pair)
- 1 Spinner 1-9 dots (1 per pair)
- 1 paper clip per pair
- 1 pen or pencil (per pair)
- Counters of two different colours (around 12 counters of one colour per person)

Preparation:

Sufficient spinners (both 1-9 numerals and 1-9 dots) need to be photocopied / printed

Spinner sheets need to be cut (two spinners per page)

Sufficient game bingo boards need to be photocopied / printed.

Spinners and game boards can be laminated for longevity, although this is not strictly necessary.

How :

The game board is placed between the two players.

Players take turns to spin both the numeral and dot spinners. They must calculate the total of the two spinners, find the total on the game board and place a counter on it. If a total is already covered by an opponents counter, it can be replaced.

The first person to get three of their counters in a row wins.

Variation:

Use a sand timer to impose a time limit per turn. If a student hasn't worked out the total in the given time, the turn passes to the other player.
